We recommend you eat your cheeses in the following order; from light to strong

Waterloo: *Guernsey cow’s milk, vegetarian, unpasteurised.*

Made on the Duke of Wellingtons estate, this brie style cheese has a french farmhouse feel.

Rich and buttery. *(Limited production so this cheese is subject to availability)*

Thomas Hoe Stevenson Aged Red Leicester: *Cow’s milk, vegetarian, pasteurised.*

Made in the Vale of Belvoir, this finest of English cheeses is matured to approximately six months giving a slightly sweet, nutty, caramelised flavour. The cheese is cloth-bound during maturation to create the rust-red rind, which makes the cheese truly authentic.

Smoked Wensleydale: *Cow’s milk, vegetarian, pasteurised*

Oak Smoked Wensleydale is cold smoked to produce a cheese with special tang and texture

Lancashire Bomb Cheddar: *Cow’s milk, vegetarian, pasteurised.*

The cheese is delivered looking like a bomb, not that that makes it taste any different! This is the best cheddar we have tasted.

Cropwell Bishop Stilton: *Cow’s milk, vegetarian, pasteurised.*

This cheese is crafted carefully by hand, using methods that have changed little since the 17th Century. It is made using vegetarian rennet and fresh, local milk.
